The Škampa Quartet is among the very finest of today's Czech string quartets. Through their mentors, the legendary Smetana Quartet, they trace their roots to the earliest quartets.

Ewart Hodge is student of composition at the Royal Northern College of Music, Manchester. He will also perform, 'Sola'.
